

2009 PACC TRAINING SCHOLARSHIPS.

Following is a listing of the scholarships we hope to offer under our 2009 MCOLES grant in the first 6 months of 2009. They are intended to cover most on-site expenses, including tuition, room and meals. PACC is cognizant that some counties have no local funds to cover the out-of-state travel, and are unable to participate in this national training. For applicants from counties which can document that their county budget does not include funding for out of state travel, PACC will seek special permission from MCOLES to reimburse up to \$500 for airfare. In all other cases, travel expenses are entirely the attendee's responsibility.

All applicants should send a letter or email indicating their professional history since law school. APAs and victim advocates should also indicate their present duties and future plans.
