Nominees should:

- Exhibit and strive to achieve continued learning in training opportunities to further enhance their abilities to combat child abuse

Nominees for the 2011 award may be involved in providing direct services, management or administration. Nominations may be submitted by any person or agency within Michigan that is involved in protecting children from child abuse.

Nomination forms must be received by June 30, 2011.

The award nominator and recipient will be notified by July 19, 2011.

The recipient of the **YOU MAKE A DIFFERENCE** 2011 service award will be recognized at the **11<sup>th</sup> Annual Multidisciplinary Conference on Child Abuse Investigations** to be held August 2-4, 2011 at the Great Wolf Lodge in Traverse City.
